Subject: Price Policy for Kharif Crops of 2012-13 season – Fixation of Minimum Support Prices.

The Government of India has fixed the Minimum Support Prices for the Kharif Crops of 2012-13 season of Fair Average Quality as under:-



- ii) the prices for different varietal groups of rice be derived from the minimum support prices of paddy on the basis of hulling / milling ratios as well as the processing and incidental charges obtaining in different states;

- (iii) the prices of varieties of cotton grown in different states, other than those in the groups of short, medium, Long and Extra Long Cotton (Kapas) be fixed keeping in view the normal market price differentials between Basic Staple Length of 24.5 mm to 25.5 mm and Micronaire value 4.3 - 5.1; Long Staple Length 29.5 mm - 30.5 mm and Micronaire value of 3.5 - 4.3 and other varieties and technical parameters;
- (iv) In the case of cereals, FCI and other designated State Agencies may continue to provide price support to the farmers, as in the past. NAFED, CWC and NCCF would continue to be the nodal agency for procurement of oilseeds and pulses and losses if any, in such operations may be fully reimbursed by the Government of India. NAFED would also continue to undertake procurement of cotton, in addition to Cotton Corporation of India (CCI).
