Sub: District-wise bi-monthly State Allotment Order of Rice, Wheat & Whole Chana for eligible PHH and AAY families (NFSA) under 'Extended Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PMGKAY-II)' for the month of September & October 2020.

Ref: Letter No F.No.7-1/2019-BP.III (Pt.) 371225 Dated 8th July 2020 of DoFPD, Government of India & Letter No.PS-03002/03/2020-PMC Dated 9th July 2020 of Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution, Department of Consumer Affairs.

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to communicate the district wise bi-monthly State Allotment Order of 27,65,176.20 quintals rice, 4,81,558.20 quintals wheat and 1,85,494.40 quintals Whole Chana for the allotment month of September & October 2020, from Central Pool for distribution among the NFSA Priority Households (PHH) and Antyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) households under 'Extended Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PMGKAY-II)' as per enclosed Annexure.

Under the scheme, both the PHH and AAY category beneficiaries are entitled to get 5 (Five) kilograms of rice or wheat or combination of both per person per month and 1 kg of whole chana per family per month, free of cost.

Those districts which have completed 90% lifting of normal allotment under NFSA & SFSS of previous allotment months, shall immediately start lifting of PMGKAY-II rice & whole chana from the RRC-cum-DSCs and make available at Fair Price Shops for distribution to beneficiaries.

The daily distribution data must be synced to FPS server so that it can be viewed in Annavitran Portal of Government of India.

The above allotted PDS stocks should be released only to those Fair Price Shops which have valid FPS license/renewal for the Financial Year 2020-21 (till March 2021). While distributing allocation for the above allotment months, the directives as issued vide this Department letter No 6109 Dated 17th March 2020 must be followed meticulously. Lifting & distribution of above allotted PDS should be started as per the timeline in the table on Page-2.

In case of quantity merging required for one to one merging of FPS quantities (total quantities of one FPS to be merged to another FPS), as per existing practice, mail to be sent from official CSO mail ID to domains.pmutpds@gmail.com in the prescribed format communicated earlier which will be given effect in SCMS for smooth lifting from RRC-cum-DSC. In case of distribution, the e-PoS device should be retrieved from the outgoing FPS Dealer and distribution should be made after downloading the allotment through the same device, without changing the configuration. Once distribution is completed and data uploaded to FPS server, the device should be re-configured in the concerned FPS code.

Distribution of above stocks at FPS points should be made only through e-PoS devices without bio-metric scanning through finger print/IRIS scanner. However, in case of any exigencies or in worst circumstances, offline/manual mode of distribution should be resorted to only after due approval of concerned ADM, BDO/EO or CSO with proper justification. In such case, the distribution data must be synced to Odisha FPS server as & when network connectivity is available to e-PoS or by the last day of distribution.

The District Civil Supplies Officer is to download the Block/ULB/FPS-wise Fair Price Shop wise allotment from the system in CSO login of OTPDS URL www.pdsodisha.gov.in and communicate it, along with the State Allotment Order letter issued from the Department, to the concerned BDOs/Sub Collectors/ADMs with copy to EO of ULBs for further action at their level. Concerned Blocks & ULBs can also download the Allotment Order in their respective RCMS login in above OTPDS URL. The FPS-wise Sales Registers have also been generated as per the above allocations and made available in the RCMS login for the Blocks and ULBs to download and use during manual transaction if any. The FPS-wise Sales Register has also been made available for download in the e-PoS devices to carry out distribution of food grain entitlement of beneficiaries. This should be downloaded in PoS device and distribution should be made accordingly through PoS device.

- Per Card entitlement of rice shall not be reduced below the prescribed allotment. Minimum 25% verification of sale will be conducted by the Inspector of Supplies/ACSO in charge of the Block/ULB every month.
- II. The distribution of rice shall be undertaken as per the dateline mentioned in the table below during which all the dealers will keep their shops open and keep sufficient stock for the Consumers.
- III. Certificate of GPLAC or WEAC will be obtained on proper distribution of food grains every month and submitted to the BDO/Sub Collector/ADM under counter signature of Inspector of Supplies/ACSO as per Annexure-1 of DSS Guidelines.
- IV. Out of the total allotment in favour of Gajapati district, the allotment for Garadama GP under Mohana Block of Gajapati district is diverted to Rayagada district for distribution among the PHH & AAY beneficiaries of the above GP. The CSO, Rayagada is requested to ensure lifting of the above quantities of rice and wheat from Gudari Block for smooth distribution among the genuine beneficiaries of Garadama GP under Mohana Block of Gajapati district. (Details of Garadama GP allotment & number of beneficiaries can be downloaded from RCMS CSO login under "Allotment under NFSA" link).
