RESOLUTION

Bhubaneswar, dated, the

Pending framing of rules under the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the State Government is pleased to make the following principles regulating the method of recruitment and conditions of service for appointment to the posts of Inspectors of Supplies and Market Intelligence Inspectors.

- 1. Eligibility Criteria- In order to be eligible for direct recruitment a candidate shall -
 - (a) have passed at least a Bachelor's degree or an equivalent examination from a recognized University.
 - (b) be not below the age of 21 years and above 32 years;

Provided that the upper age limit in respect of reserved categories of candidates under Para 2 shall be relaxed in accordance with the provisions of the Act, rules, orders or instructions, for the time being in force, for the respective categories.

- (c) be a citizen of India.
- (d) be able to speak, read and write Oriya and have passed a language test in Oriya equivalent to the Middle School Standard.
- (e) be of sound health, good physique, active habits and free from organic defects or bodily infirmity.
- (f) have not more than one spouse living.
- **2. Reservations** Notwithstanding anything contained in these principles reservation of vacancies or posts, as the case may be, for -
 - (a) Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes shall be made in accordance with the provisions of the Orissa Reservation of Vacancies in Posts and Services (for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes) Act,1975 and the rules made there under or any other law or rule in force at the relevant time; and

(b) S.E.B.C., Women, Sportsmen, Ex-Servicemen and Physically Handicapped Persons shall be made in accordance with the provisions made under such rules, orders or instructions issued in this behalf by the Government from time to time.

3. Procedure for Selection -

- (i) The selection of candidates shall be made on the basis of the marks secured by them in the Secondary (Matriculation), Higher Secondary (+ 2) and Graduation Examinations conducted by a recognized Board, Council, or University, as the case may be.
- (ii) Following weightage shall be assigned to the marks obtained by the candidates in the examinations.

Secondary (Matriculation) :- 30%

Higher Secondary (Plus two) :- 30%

Graduation (Bachelor's degree) :- 40%

- (iii) The merit list shall be drawn up on the basis of weighted percentage of marks obtained in the three examinations mentioned in sub-para (i) and (ii) of this paragraph.
- (iv) In case more than one candidate has equal weightage percentage of marks, the candidate with higher percentage of marks in Degree examination shall be assigned higher rank in merit. In case this also become the same, the candidate older in age shall be placed above the younger.
- **4. Constitution of Selection Committee** (1) There shall be constituted a Selection Committee for recruitment to the posts with the following members, namely:-
 - (a) Additional Secretary, F.S. & C.W. Department ... Chairman
 - (b) DCA-cum-Joint Secretary, F. S. & C.W. Department ... Member
 - (c) Under Secretary, S.T. & S.C. Dev. Department ... Member
 - (d) Under Secretary, F.S.& C.W. Department ... Member Convenor

(2) The recommendation of the Committee shall be valid and can be operated upon notwithstanding the absence of any one of its members other than the Chairman:

Provided that the member so absenting was duly invited to attend the meeting of the Committee and the majority of members of the Committee attended the meeting.

- (3) While preparing the merit list the Committee shall follow the Orissa Civil Services (Criteria for Selection for Appointment including Promotion) Rules, 2003.
- **5. Select List** (1) The list prepared by the Committee after being approved by the Government, shall form the select list for appointment to the posts.
- (2) The select list shall ordinarily remain in force for a period of year from the date of its approval by the Government or until another select list is prepared afresh.
- (3) Appointment to the posts shall be made in the order the names of the persons appear in the select list.
- **6. Probation and Confirmation** (1) Every person appointed to these posts shall be on probation for a period of two years from the date of joining the post :

Provided that the appointing authority may, if think fit in any case or class of cases, extend the period of probation.

Provided further that such period of probation shall not include -

- (a) extraordinary leave;
- (b) period of unauthorized absence; or
- (c) any other period held to be not being on actual duty.
- (2) The appointment of a probationer may, for good and sufficient reasons to be recorded in writing, be terminated by Government at any time without previous notice during the period of probation including extension of such period, if any.

- (3) A probationer after completing the period of probation to the satisfaction of Government shall be eligible for confirmation subject to the availability of substantive vacancy in the service.
- **7. Inter-se-seniority** The inter-se-seniority of the employees appointed to the service in a particular year shall be in the order in which their names appear in the select list.
