The HMs of the designated schools should follow the guideline scrupulously as mentioned below under the supervision of BDOS concerned/DWOs/Dist administration

- 1. Observation of world Consumer Rights Day on 15<sup>th</sup> March in School campus.
- 2. Display and dissemination of Consumer awareness related publicity materials during local weekly hats, melas & local festival by the students.
- Wall writing on the PDS out lets having address of respective District Forum & National Helpline No. 1800-11-4000, State Consumer Help line 1800-3456724.
- 4. Display of Consumer Awareness massage in local language at the Schools/ Village Mandis & other prominent places.
- Dissemination of Consumer Awareness message through local folk tromps, Palas, Dasakathia, magic shows, Rallies etc in the School campus or outside the school.
- 6. Development of folk songs, audio cassettes and distribution thereof amongst the students of the School.
- 7. Publishing & distribution of hand bills/ pamphlets in local languages on Consumer Awareness Programmes on PDS for distribution among school students.
- 8. Organising debates, exhibitions, essays competitions among students from primary level to 10<sup>th</sup> class level on issues relating to Consumer Awareness and distribution prize to the winners 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> in their levels.
  - i) Primary- up to 5<sup>th</sup> class
  - ii) Upper Primary- up to 6<sup>th</sup> -7<sup>th</sup> class
  - iii) High School- 8<sup>th</sup> class to 10<sup>th</sup> class.
