Sub: Bi-monthly State Allotment of Rice under Annapurna Scheme for the Month of February & March 2020.

Sir,

I am directed to communicate the district wise allotment of **5,868.20 quintals** of rice under Annapurna Scheme for the month of **February & March 2020** as indicated in the enclosed statement for distribution to the beneficiaries under Annapurna Scheme. The rice allotted under the scheme shall be distributed to the beneficiaries @10 kg per card per month free of cost. The unutilized rice under Annapurna Scheme kept with them may be surrendered to Govt. for re-allotment of the same to the districts. Since Central allocation of rice under Annapurna Scheme has not yet been received from Government of India, Ministry of Rural Development, the above allotted quantity shall be lifted out of State pool subject to recoupment of the same from the Central pool.

The beneficiaries those who are already covered under NOAPS have been kept in Annapurna Suspect List-3 (NOAPS). The ISs/MIs l/c of Blocks/ULBs shall be directed to make field verification and if the beneficiary found eligible, shall be moved to Final Annapurna List. Further, an existing beneficiary under Annapurna scheme, if found not existing either in NFSA or SFSS database based on identification through Aadhaar, shall be moved to eligible list.

THE ALLOTTED STOCKS OF RICE SHOULD BE RELEASED ONLY TO THOSE FAIR PRICE SHOPS WHICH HAVE VALID FPS LICENSE/RENEWAL FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2019-20 (TILL MARCH 2020).

The FPS-wise allotment has been uploaded in RCMS login which shall be downloaded and circulated among all concerned under intimation to the concerned M.Ps/M.L.As/Chairman Municipality/PS.

Distribution of stocks at FPS points should be made only through e-PoS devices along with NFSA & SFSS distribution. However, in case of any exigencies or in worst circumstances, manual mode of distribution should be resorted to only after due approval of concerned ADM, BDO/EO or CSO with proper justification. In such case, the stock/sales records must be kept for future reference/verification & the physical balance should be entered by Marketing Inspectors in the FPS portal for the concerned Fair Price Shop (FPS) at the end of the distribution.

The District Civil Supplies Officer is to download the Block/ULB/FPS-wise Fair Price Shop wise allotment from the system in CSO login of OTPDS URL www.pdsodisha.gov.in (Allotment under NFSA link given in MIS Report section) and communicate it along with the State Allotment Order letter issued from the Department to the concerned BDOs/Sub Collectors/ADMs with copy to EO of ULBs for further action at their level. Concerned Blocks & ULBs can also download the Allotment Order in their respective RCMS login in above OTPDS URL. The FPS-wise Sales Registers have also been generated as per the above allocations and made available in the RCMS login for the Blocks and ULBs to download and use during manual transaction if any. The FPS-wise Sales Register has also been made available for download



in the e-PoS devices to carry out distribution of food grain entitlement of beneficiaries. This should be downloaded in PoS device on or after 1st date of the allotment month and distribution should be made accordingly through PoS device.


