Sub :- **State Pool allotment of BPL rice for S.T. & S.C. Hostels for the months from July, 2009 to March, 2010.**

Sir,

I am directed to communicate district wise allotment of 3117.735 MT of BPL rice for S.T. & S.C. Hostels for each month from July, 2009 to March, 2010 from the State Pool as per the quantity mentioned against each in the annexure enclosed. The scale of entitlement will be limited to at the rate of 12 Kg. per inmate up to Class-VII and @ 15 Kg. per inmate from Class-VIII to +3 @ of Rs.2/- per Kg. The entire quantity of this allotment will be provided by the O.S.C.S.C. Ltd. from the State Pool.

2. The validity period for depositing cost and lifting of allotted food grains for the months of July, 2009 to November, 2009 will be upto fifty days from the date of issue of the Government of India letter dated 13.10.2009 and for the remaining period for depositing the cost and lifting the food grains thereof will be 15th and 20th of each allocation month respectively. This allocation may be distributed only amongst the S.T. & S.C. Hostels as per the list provided by the S.T. & S.C. Development Department on the basis of intake capacity and the number of inmates approved by the S.T. & S.C. Development Department.


3. There will be no diversion of rice from other schemes hence forth with.

4. Institutions should be given entitlement cards to enable them to draw rice. The Officer of concerned Department will certify utilization of stock for bonafide purpose in the card every month.

5. The institutions will lift their quota from the concerned Storage Agents and they will not be asked to lift rice from F.C.I. / D.P.C. Depots. Storage Agent will issue Cash Memo to the institution and obtain signature.


6. In case closing stock is available with the institutions equal quantity will be reduced from the allocation for the next month. However, full quota of Central Pool and State Pool must be lifted by O.S.C.S.C. Ltd. / Storage Agent and no quantity should be allowed to lapse.




