The B.D.Os /Sub-Collectors may be instructed to communicate the dealer wise allotment to the GPs and concerned retailers for information of general public. Intensive measures be undertaken to make available of levy sugar at the prescribed scale to genuine consumers and stringent action to be taken against the offending retailers indulging in black-marketing and charging higher premium.

You are, requested to distribute sugar based on allotment. A stock of 30.3 MT of sugar may be distributed to CRPF as per their demand.
