Allotment of APL Wheat for the year 2010-2011

(for the month of March, 2011).

Sir,

In suppression to this Department Letter No-18202, dt-11.10.2010 on the subject cited above, I am directed to communicate district-wise allotment of 32574 MT of APL wheat for month of March, 2011 only as per the quantity mentioned against each district and principles as per Annexure until further orders. The allocation may be considered under the APL wheat category of the T.P.D.S. The Collectors of Angul, Cuttack, Dhenkanal, Jajpur, Kendrapara, Khordha, Nayagarh and Puri districts are requested to fix minimum entitlement of APL wheat @ 15 Kg. per card per month for all APL consumers of urban areas. Besides, the Collector, Cuttack is requested to ensure distribution of APL wheat to all the APL beneficiaries of 4 G.Ps namely Utarkula, Manijang, Babujang and Mahammadpur under Nischintakoili Block of Cuttack district henceforth and compliance reported to the Department Urgently.

The validity period for depositing the cost and lifting of wheat will be as applicable under TPDS. All other terms and conditions will remain un-altered. It will be mandatory to deposit the cost of food grains to F.C.I. latest by 15th of each allocation month. However, lifting of food grains in installments against allocations within the validity period will be allowed.

The C.S.O.-cum-D.M. O.S.C.S.C. Ltd. may be suitably instructed to take immediate steps for lifting of allotted quantity of APL Wheat from F.C.I.

Copies of sub-allocation of APL wheat may be made in favour of Blocks / NACs/ Municipalities along with scale of supply may also be made available to concerned MPs/ MLAs /Youth Association/ Mahila Samities/ Chairman Panchayat Samities and Municipalities under intimation to this Department . Sub-Collectors and B.D.Os may be instructed to communicate dealer wise allotment to G.Ps with information of the concerned dealers for information of General Public.

Collectors are instructed to ensure that the allotted quantity is distributed to the genuine card holders as per the principles mentioned below:-

- (i) The minimum entitlement of APL wheat may be fixed at 10 Kg per card per month for both Urban and Rural APL card holders except the urban areas of 8 districts mentioned therein.
- (ii) While making the intra-district allocation of APL wheat Collectors will take into account the demand for APL wheat so that the APL Wheat is supplied to genuine consumers and there is no diversion of wheat to black market.
- (iii) Per family entitlement of APL wheat will not be reduced below the prescribed minimum allotment. If any F.P.S's report that APL wheat allocation is inadequate for supply to all consumers who approach the F.P.S., a 100% verification of sale will be conducted by the Inspector of Supplies along with the RLAC Chairman and referred to Collector for additional allocation.
- (iv) The destitution of APL Wheat may be taken up on fixed distribution days during which all the dealers will keep their shops open and keep sufficient stock for the Consumers. In view of the above, APL wheat may be distributed on eight fixed distribution days namely, 11th, 12th, 13th, 14th, 26th 27th, 28th & 29th day of every month.
- (v) Undistributed allotment of wheat will be added on to the allotment of next quarter and Collector may enhance the per capita entitlement for families on a quarterly basis for full utilization of quota within the district.
- (vi) Certificate of RLAC will be obtained on the proper distribution of APL wheat every month and submitted to the C.S.O. with counter signature of Inspector of Supplies.

In case the allocation is not required by any district the same may be surrendered at the earliest to enable its re-allocation and utilization elsewhere.
