Implementation of the proposed scheme of Rs. 2/- a Kg rice to Differently Abled Persons (PWDs') having 75% disabilities and above.

Sir,

You must be aware of the announcement made by Hon'ble Chief Minister, Odisha on the International Disabled Day for making provision of Rs. 2/- a Kg rice for the persons having 75% disabilities and above. In the meantime, the proposed scheme has already been approved by the Government and has also been inaugurated by the Hon'ble Minister, Women & Child Development on 19.12.2011 in Benapanjari GP of Jatni Block, Khordha District.

The proposed scheme envisages distribution of Rs. 2/- a Kg rice to the identified individual beneficiaries i.e., Persons With Disabilities (PWDs') having 75% disabilities @ 10 Kgs per beneficiary irrespective of any category i.e., BPL or APL with effect from the date of its inauguration.

Now to make the said scheme operational across the State, a joint discussion was held between F.S. & C.W. Department and W & CD Department to decide the steps and responsibilities in implementation of the proposed scheme of Rs. 2/- a Kg Rice to Differently Able Persons (PWDs') having 75% disabilities and above.

It is therefore requested that as per the decision taken in the matter, the following steps may be under taken by you scrupulously adhering to the datelines specified against some of the points to implement the scheme in a systematic manner.


1. For the purpose of identification of beneficiaries i.e., Differently able persons having 75% disabilities and above under the proposed scheme, SEO will collect information of each identified beneficiary at block / ULB level by 12.03.2012. The data will be collected in a prescribed format enclosed with this letter.
2. F.S. & C.W. Department will develop a web based software with entry screen for data entry by 12.3.2012.
3. Data entry would be done in a decentralized manner by accessing website of F.S. & C.W. Department i.e., foododisha.in. Data entry will be done at Block / ULB level by the Data Entry Operators of the concerned blocks. The validation of the data entry will be made by the concerned SEO/ MI. Authorization of data entry will be done by the concerned BDO for Blocks and by the Sub-Collector for ULB level after verifying the records and certifying the same. The entire process of data entry should be completed by 26.03.2012.
4. Generation of Bar Coded Ration Cards will be made at Block / ULB level. After printing the cards, the photograph of the individual identified beneficiary may be affixed on the Bar Coded Ration Cards and may be laminated thereafter. Separate paper for monthly entry of issue will be stapled to the laminated cover page of the Ration Card. This process should be completed by 09.04.2012.
5. Distribution of ration cards at GP / Ward level or Block / ULB level will be done by Women & Child Development Department with proper identification. This should be completed by 18.04.2012 as there are hardly 100-400 beneficiaries of Block / ULB.
6. Generation of MIS reports.
  - i. FPS Dealer wise beneficiaries list → to be handed over to concerned FPS dealer.
  - ii. GP / Ward wise / Block / ULB wise beneficiaries list → To be kept as record in these offices for future reference.
7. Sharing of FPS data with dealers / inspectors / CSOs will be made through the supply chain of the F.S. & C.W. Department.
8. Allocation, Lifting & Issue of Rs. 2/- a Kg. rice to beneficiaries under the respective scheme will also be made by the F.S. & C.W. Department. The


allocation, lifting & issue of rice should definitely start from 10<sup>th</sup> instant of April 2012 after completion of above mentioned exercises.

9. For online data entry, a detailed Instruction Manual will be sent to all Collectors from F.S. & C.W. Department by e-Despatch & Fax through the CSOs.

Top priority should be accorded for completion of the entire process as enumerated above within the stipulated time line and compliance may be reported from time to time.
