RDP validation of data base for differently able person for distribution of rice
@ Rs. 2/- per Kg

Sir,

In inviting a reference to the subject mentioned supra, I am to say that exhaustive instructions were issued vide F.S. & C.W. Department letter No.3683 dt.23.02.2012 for online data entry of the information for preparation of Special PDS Card for differently able persons having 75% of disabilities and above with a stipulation to complete the entire process of data entry by 26.03.2012. Instructions were also hoisted on F.S. & C.W. Department website i.e. www.foododisha.in as regards validation and authorization of such data.

But it reveals from the status of the RDP registration as on 21.04.2012, that 40041 numbers of registration has been made out of these only 19 cases have been validated. Some of the districts have less than 100 numbers of registrations of differently able persons.

These lagging districts with number of registrations are:

1. Boudh-4,
2. Deogarh-1,
3. Dhenkanal-1,
4. Kendrapara-1,
5. Nayagarh-2,
6. Sambalpur-5,
7. Sonepur-35,
8. Keonjhar-54 and
9. Nuapada-88.

Keeping in view the urgency in the matter and low rate of registration in above nine & some other districts, I would like to request you to impart necessary instructions to your concerned field functionaries to accelerate the process of data entry and to complete the same as expeditiously as possible.

The following steps may be undertaken while validating and authorizing the data of differently able persons having 75% disabilities and above:

1. For the purpose of validation, access can be made into the FS & CW Department Home Page (www.foododisha.in). After having accessed in to it, one can see the "Online Disability Registration" (New) portion. One has to click on the 'Report' to get the screen of 'Differently Able Registration Status Report'

Please select your respective District/ then Block/ ULB from dropdown list by clicking on 'show' button. It will give a table of names of registered beneficiaries.

2. To have a printout of the table containing the details of differently able persons who have already registered, 'print' button can be clicked on the right hand corner of the screen. This print can be taken at each Block / ULB to start the verification / validation process.
3. Validation of each entry with reference to original record/register is to be done at appropriate level. Blatant mistakes like 'Husband' for a mole beneficiary is to be corrected.
4. Multiple entries should be deleted and the correct entry should be marked as 'OK' in the remark column.
5. At the stage, the Inspector of Supplies or the Marketing Inspector has to verify the FPS tagged for distribution. Only those FPS who are dealing with PDS rice within the GP / Ward as the RDP will have to be selected. Instances have occurred in some cases where the FPS dealing with only S.K.Oil have been chosen by the differently able persons for the scheme. This is to be modified in remark column.
6. BDO from Block and E.O. from Municipality shall validate the list and hand over the same to the CSO with a covering letter as a proof of authentication of list.
7. CSO/Asst. Programmer will update the data/authorize the same in data base for generating unique RDP code (of nine digits).
8. The BDOs of Blocks/ Executive Officers of ULBs will be given user ID/ password through respective CSOs to login and take printout of RDP ration cards. They are to laminate the cover page & staple the distribution page. Distribution shall be done at GP / Ward level in a proper public function.
9. Sample copy of RDP card, both cover page & distribution page is enclosed for reference.
