Sub:- Allotment of rice under Annapurna scheme for the months from April, 2010 to September, 2010.

Sir,

I am directed to communicate the district wise break up of 648 MT of rice for each month of April, 2010 to September, 2010 as indicated in the statement for distribution to the beneficiaries under Annapurna scheme. The validity period for depositing of cost and lifting of the food grains for the months of April and May, 2010 will be 45 days and 50 days respectively from the date of issue of Government of India letter No. 4-4/2010 -B.P-II, dt-28.4.2010. For the remaining months, the validity period for deposit of cost and lifting of food grains will be as per ^{the} extant guidelines dated-18.7.2008.

The allotted rice may be lifted immediately from the FSD, FCI as per the quantity mentioned below against their districts and ensure distribution to the beneficiaries @ 10Kg per card free of cost. The unutilized rice under Annapurna scheme kept with them may be surrendered to Government for re-allotment of the same to the district.

Out of allotment of 23.15 MT of rice under Annapurna scheme for Kalahandi district 0.25 MT of rice is diverted to Rayagada district for distribution to the Annapurna beneficiaries of Kerpai, Gopinathpur, Odri & Malligaon G.Ps of Th. Rampur Block. Similarly, out of 20.76 MT of rice under Annapurna scheme for Jagatsinghpur district 0.46 MT of rice is diverted to Cuttack district for distribution to the Annapurna beneficiaries of Uttarkul, Manijanga, Babujang & Mahammadpur G.Ps of Nischintakoili Block under Cuttack district.

Municipality/ NAC/Block/ G.P wise distribution of the allotted stock of rice may be made under intimation to the concerned M.Ps/ MLAs/ Chairman Municipality/ P.S.

The rice stock should be distributed to the beneficiaries at the place & time as communicated vide this Department letter No-14261, dt-29.5.2002. Necessary steps may be taken to replenish the BPL rice, if utilized from the present allocation.
