Sub: Allotment of special adhoc/ additional rice for BPL families under TPDS for the month of July, 2011.

Sir,

In supersession of this Department Letter No-10041, dt-9.6.2011 I am directed to communicate district-wise allocation of 18455.725 MT of special adhoc/ additional BPL rice for the month of July, 2011 under TPDS. The break up of 18455.725 MT of rice is mentioned in Annexure.

The above allocation is purely adhoc in nature and will not form the basis of future allocation. The allocated food grains may be distributed to the bonafide BPL families under TPDS. You are requested to please ensure strict Vigilance so that no leakage/ diversion of the allotted quantities take place at any stage. It is further requested to give wide publicity to this allocation so as to create awareness amongst the eligible TPDS beneficiaries.


The validity period for deposit of cost and lifting of the allotted quantities will be till 30th June, 2011. The allocation may be lifted for the month of July, 2011 in advance also. Besides, the allocated quantities should be lifted early so as to ensure that benefits reach the intended beneficiaries. The Collectors are requested to kindly take step for lifting of the special adhoc/ additional BPL rice so as to facilitate distribution of 5 Kg. of rice to the beneficiaries for the month of July, 2011 to avoid lapse of the quota.

Each BPL families is entitled to lift a quantity of 5 Kgs of special adhoc/ additional BPL rice @ Rs. 2/- per Kg per month.

Copies of sub allocation may be supplied to concerned Hon'ble M.Ps/ MLAs and Chairperson of P.S for their information.

Moreover, you are requested to reduce the quota according to the number of Ration Cards cancelled during the campaign from November, 2010 to December, 2010, at the time of making sub-allocation to the blocks and ULBs of the districts.
