Release of allocation of food grains under NFSA, 2013 for the month of **December, 2015-Revised allocation**.

Madam,

With reference to the letter on the subject cited above, I would draw your kind attention to the following facts:

1. Government of India had been requested vide above referred letter on 02.11.2015 to release allocation of **1,35,810.467 MTs** of Rice and **24,019.348 MTs** of Wheat under NFSA, 2013 for distribution among 2,67,36,830 number of individuals of Priority Households (PHH) and 7,47,019 number of Antyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) families identified under NFSA, 2013 in the State for the allotment month of December, 2015. In the meantime i.e. when we received Government of India allocation on 30.11.2015, the number of individuals in Priority Household List has been increased to 2,67,78,632 (an increase of 41,802 individuals) and number of Antyodaya Anna Yojana families to 7,48,068 (an increase of 1,049 families).

Thus, requirement of food grains has now increased to 1,35,937.743 MTs of Rice and 24,137.797 MTs of Wheat.

- 2. As against the above requirement, Government of India has released 1,25,628.216 MTs of Rice and 33,737.782 MTs of Wheat under NFSA for the month of December, 2015 vide letter No 1-8/2013-BP-III (Vol. II) dated 24.11.2015. Hence, there is a **shortfall** of 10,309.527 MTs of **Rice** and an **excess** of 9,599.985 MTs **Wheat** in the allocations released by Government of India.
- 3. The increase in beneficiaries' strength of 41,802 individuals under PHH and 1,049 families under AAY is due to dynamic up-dation of beneficiaries database which has been kept open for inclusion of eligible beneficiaries after verification in field. However, the identified number of beneficiaries is well within the ceiling fixed by Government of India under the NFSA'2013.

After data consolidation, the revised strength of beneficiaries under PHH & AAY categories have been derived as under:

District wise allotment of Foodgrains (Rice & Wheat) against PHH and AAY families under NFSA-2013 for the month of December, 2015.

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to communicate district wise allocation of 1359377.43 quintal of rice and 241377.97 quintal of wheat from Central Pool for distribution among the Priority Households (PHH) and Antodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) households under NFSA-2013 for the month of December, 2015 as per enclosed Annexure.

Online Allotment Orders are being generated District wise for both PHH & AAY beneficiaries as per details in the newly issued ration cards. The District Administration (Civil Supplies Officer) is to generate Fair Price Shop wise allotment order from the system for each Block and ULB and communicate it to the concerned BDOs/ Sub Collectors/ ADMs with copy to EO of ULBs for further action at their level.

As per the provision of NFSA-2013 and as per decision of Government of Odisha, the PHH are entitled to get 5 (Five) Kilograms of food grain (rice, wheat or combination of both) per person per month @ Re.1/- per Kg. The AAY beneficiaries will continue to get 35 Kgs. of rice per household per month @ Re.1/- per Kg.

All existing ration cards under different schemes like BPL, AAY, APL, PLO, RORC, RDP shall stand cancelled w.e.f **01.11.2015** in 1st phase of 14 districts & 01.12.2015 in 2nd phase of 16 districts under NFSA' 2013. The food grains (rice or wheat or both) shall be distributed to the PHH & AAY households against new ration cards issued under NFSA-2013 at the above prescribed rates.

- The per card entitlement of food grains (rice, wheat or combination of both) @ 5 kg per person per month @Re 1/- per kg shall be distributed to the priority house hold (PHH) under NFSA 2013.
- II. Per Card entitlement of food grains will not be reduced below the prescribed allotment. 100% verification of sale will be conducted by the Inspector of Supplies/ACSO in charge of the Block/ULB.

- 111. The distribution of food grains may be taken up on fixed distribution days decided earlier during which all the dealers will keep their shops open and keep sufficient stock for the Consumers. For month of Dedember'2015, the distribution may be done continuously for six days starting from 16th to 21st of the month due to delay in initiation of the scheme under NFSA. However, those beneficiaries who are not able to buy their stock with in above date may be allowed to buy their entitlements by 31st December, 2015.
- IV. If any entitled/ eligible ration card holder fails to receive his /her guota of PDS commodities on the fixed days of distribution, he/she may be allowed to receive the same till the end of the month after 21st.
- V. All the PDS distribution should be completed by end of the month.
- VI. Undistributed allotment of food grains will be considered while finalising the allotment for the next month.
- VII. Certificate of GPLAC or WLAC will be obtained on proper distribution of food grains every month and submitted to the BDO/Sub Collector/ADM with counter signature of Inspector of Supplies/ACSO as per Annexure-1 of DSS Guidelines.

The CSOs-cum-DMs may be suitably instructed to take immediate steps for deposit of cost of wheat latest by 9th of the December, 2015 with FCI and ensure lifting of the allotted quantity of wheat from FCI by 15th December, 2015 positively. They are to be instructed to arrange rice at the DSC-cum-RRC for distribution to FPS by 15th December, 2015.

Copies of sub-allocation may be made available to concerned MPs / MLAs / Chairpersons of Blocks/ULBs for their kind information under intimation to this Department.

You are requested to ensure distribution of foodgrains to the genuine ration card holders.
