Sub: Allotment of S.K.O. for the month of April, May & June, 2016. Sir/Madam,

I am directed to intimate that a quantity of 30852 K.L. Kerosene Oil for each month of April, May & June, 2016 is hereby distributed among all the districts on the basis of beneficiaries strength of the district as per following break up in multiples of 12 kl. so as not to allow lapses of allotted quantity to any district. The entire quantity of monthly allotment is to be lifted during the month of April, May & June, 2016 positively. Due care should be taken on the following points at the time of distribution of SK Oil.

- 1. The allotted SK Oil will only be distributed to ration card (both PHH and AAY ration card) holders of the district on per head basis @1 ltr per head per month for the family having members 5 or less and @5 ltrs per family having 6 members or more.
- 2. The balance SK Oil remains surplus out of district quota after distribution as per specification at para 1 above may be utilized to meet the requirement of new ration card holders issued during the ongoing quarter and also to meet the exigencies.
- 3. After distribution as per specification at para 1 & 2, if there will be any surplus at the end of the month of May, 2016 the same will be distributed in the month of June, 2016 together with the monthly allocation of June, 2016 on per head basis.

The balance SK Oil out of monthly quota 'if any remains at the end of each month' the same may be carried forward to meet the demand in subsequent month.

You are requested to lift the stocks of SKO from the respective oil companies. The wholesalers of your district should lift the entire stocks by 25th of the month. The C.S.O. should monitor the lifting of SKO by 10th, 20th and 25th of the

month and report to Government about progress of lifting of SKO Problem if any such as non-availability of SKO with the company or bottleneck in transport etc. may be brought to the notice of Government.

The District level S.K. Oil distribution plan should be prepared taking into consideration number of beneficiaries (both PHH & AAY), area of operation and wholesaler wise monthly SK Oil quota etc.

Due care should be taken that PDS Kerosene is not diverted otherwise or misused for adulteration in MS / HSD retail outlets or commercial vehicles. Stringent action be taken against dealers found indulged in such unfair trade practices. Wide publicity be made on distribution, scale and quantum of supply.

The copy of the Block and Town-wise distribution of SKO may please be communicated to the Chairman of Advisory Committees to check misuse of Kerosene under intimation to this Department. The utilization of SKO is meant for cooking and lighting purpose only.
