under TPDS for the month of November, 2015.

Madam / Sir,

I am directed to say that State Govt. is going to implement NFSA-2013 in 14 districts of the State with effect from 1st November, 2015 in 1st phase. As such district-wise allotment of 9530.350 MT of rice is communicated for distribution among the PLO families of 7 districts for the month of November, 2015 as per annexure. The allotted quantity may be distributed @ 25 Kg per family / beneficiaries @ Re.1/- per Kg. per month identified under the above scheme. This allotment will be lifted from State pool as no allotment of rice under the said scheme has been released by Government of India till today.

The total number of 381214 poorest families of 7 districts may be covered under the scheme.

You are requested to deposit the cost of the said rice so much in advance latest by 20th October, 2015. The lifting of rice should be completed by 31st October, 2015 positively and distributed to the genuine beneficiaries/families within the stipulated period.

You are requested to kindly furnish lifting position of above rice and its distribution every month by the 5th of the subsequent month positively in the prescribed proforma to this Department without fail.

Copies of sub-allocation may be supplied to concerned Hon'ble M.Ps / M.L.As and Chairperson of P.S. for their kind information.
